
THE M+S TIRE IS NOT A WINTER TIRE HERE'S WHY:

THE GREAT TIRE DIVIDE

3-Season Tire

M+S tires are all-season tires and their rubber compound begins to harden once temperatures fall below +7°C.





Ingredients are added to

Winter Tire

Only tires with this symbol (3-peak mountain snowflake) are true winter tires, tested for snow traction and performance in temperatures below +7°C.



NOTE: a winter tire will carry both the M+S and the 3-peak mountain snowflake symbol
